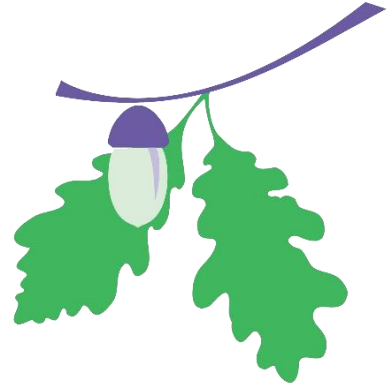


Oak Hill First School
