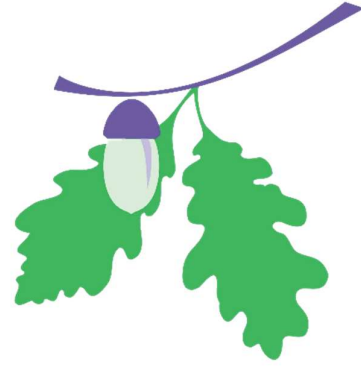

This week we were delighted to welcome the Trust Lead for Attendance into school to carry out a full review of our practice and the culture we have built around attendance. As you may be aware, attendance continues to be a major focus nationally, with the government placing strong emphasis on ensuring children are in school regularly and ready to learn.

At Oak Hill, we firmly believe that children should be in school every day that they are well. Our aim is to create a culture where children *want* to come to school—where they feel safe, happy, and excited to learn—and where families feel supported every step of the way.
