Free School Meals – Important Information for Families

You may be aware that there are some changes to Free School Meals from September 2026. These changes mean that more families may be able to access support, but they also introduce different types of Free School Meals.

We know this can feel a little confusing, so we've set out a simple explanation below. It's really important to take a moment to check this, as it may affect your child's entitlement and the support we are able to provide in school.
