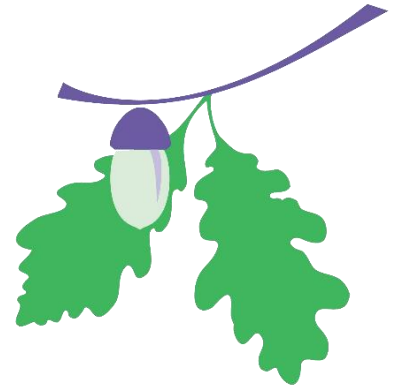


Oak Hill First School

Summer Reading Challenge 2026

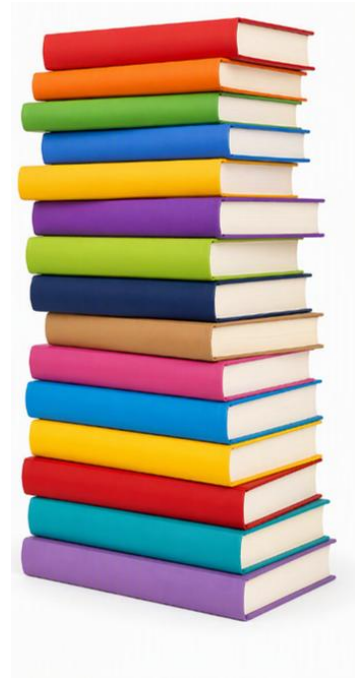
Looking for a fun and free activity over the summer holidays?
